Gary Standige studied ceramics at Stoke on Trent College of Art and then went to the Royal College of Art where he studied mainly sculpture. In 1970 he was awarded the Sanderson Scholarship to travel to America and Canada studying computer technology and its influence on Art and Design. Gary taught full-time on the Pottery Course at Medway College of Design for 5 years up to September 1982, he is now a full-time lecturer at West Surrey College of Art and Design at Farnham, Surrey. Gary has a workshop at his home near Maidstone in Kent with a 13 cu. ft catenary arch kiln fired by propane gas. He makes individual pieces in stoneware and porcelain often decorated by carving and sgraffito and glazed with celadon and ash glazes.
