How the competition works:

The **deadline** for completion of entries is **September (exact date to be confirmed)** so that pieces can be displayed at the Kingsbury Barn Exhibition before members vote online on the shortlist, in the week after the exhibition closes.

Entries, with the following details: your contact details, your name, the title of the piece, must be brought to the Kingsbury Barn on Thursday setting up day to be displayed and photographed for the members' online vote, which will take place after the exhibition ends.

We will verify that you are a paid up member of The DCPG, photograph your piece for the online vote and display it in the barn for all to see.

There will be an online vote by members to shortlist the entries for a formal members' vote (how we organise this will be decided nearer the time).

The announcement for the winning piece and two runners up, and the public's favourite, will be given after the formal business of the AGM in October.

You will be responsible for bringing your piece to the Barn and for collecting it at the end of the exhibition.

There will be an anonymous public vote during the Exhibition, with a special prize for the 'public's favourite' winner.
